Stop at the picturesque Dolgoch Falls, surrounded by mosses, ferns, beautiful trees and wild flowers, offers a series of waterfalls perfect for a spot of exploration in the wild outdoors. There is plenty of wildlife to see here as well. Stop alongside the Tallylyn Lakeside and enjoy a picnic in the tranquil setting for lunch! Your final stop of the day will give you the chance to climb the rocky Craig yr Aderyn hill, a site of Special Scientific Interest and part of the Snowdonia Centre of Excellence. This area is renowned for wildlife, particularly birds. See if you can spot any cormorants during your stop as this area is meant to support the only regular inland breeding colony in Wales! Tonight you will enjoy a private mixology class on-site featuring the finest Welsh spirits. (B,L,D)
